**RE: Covid-19 Update**

Governor Eric J. Holcomb issued a new two-week Stay At Home order designed to limit interactions among Hoosiers to increase containment of COVID-19. In light of what is happening around us this makes sense. As of today, 6,351 people have tested positive in Indiana and 245 people have died from the disease. There are now positive tests in 89 of 92 counties. Wabash County confirms 6 identified cases of Covid-19, no fatalities as of yet and a total of 63 people tested. The reality for our county is that only a few are being tested, and those who are tested wait up to 14 days for results. Therefore the cases in our area are likely higher than reported.

While you as a Neighborhood Home resident are able to leave the campus for essential business such as medically necessary appointments, grocery shopping and medication pick-ups at your pharmacy, I want to reiterate that your Timbercrest Management Team urges you follow the recommendations of the Indiana Department of Health, the Governor and the Center for Disease Control in order to mitigate the risk of infection. This includes:

- The practice of social distancing at all times including when visiting through an open window or patio door;
- Wearing a facemask outside of your home;
- Limiting your movements away from home by ordering on line for curbside pickup or mail-order, and utilize drive thrus at the pharmacy;
- Taking advantage of CVS delivering your prescriptions via the US Postal Service (except for meds needing refrigeration and controlled substances) or Webb Pharmacy's delivery to the home.
- Having a family member or friend drop off necessary items at your front porch.

Timbercrest Shopping services and transportation to necessary medical appointments are still available at this time.
