**RE: Community Update**

On Monday, we received word that test results were negative for Covid-19 on behalf of three staff members! Consequently, residents were released from quarantine status. However, on Tuesday morning we have heard from another staff member who was sent to be tested by their physician due to symptoms. Subsequently, several residents in Health Care were placed in quarantine while waiting for the test result.

As restrictions are loosened in Indiana and nationwide, Timbercrest Senior Living Community continues to have stringent restrictions following the guidelines by the Center for Medicare and Medicaid, Indiana State Department of Health, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

At this time Timbercrest continues to:

- Conduct risk assessments and temperature checks on all staff upon entering the building, and when leaving after their shift.
- Require staff to wear face masks at all times.
- Require residents in Health Care, Crestwood and Residential to wear facemasks outside their apartments, and when staff and/or other residents are in their rooms.
- Practice social distancing.
- Perform stringent cleaning protocols.
- Restrict visitors and encourage visits by phone, via virtual technology or through windows.
- Have family and friends drop off shopping and gifts at the Main Entrance, allowing no in-person deliveries to residents in the Manor by family and friends.

The Timbercrest Management team appreciates your understanding and cooperation with following these restrictions. With Memorial Day weekend upon us, we look to the families of residents to help them by adhering to the guidelines mentioned above. We will continue to provide you with updates.
