Re: COVID-19 Status Update

COVID-19 cases are on the rise in Wabash County as well as in the North Manchester community. As reported today we have 3 new cases at Timbercrest. Staff are working diligently to follow the state and federal guidelines to prioritize your health and safety. Your commitment to the community is vital as well. Continue to wear your masks, wash your hands well and often, and remain a safe distance away from others.

At this time, heightened restrictions will continue through Monday, November 16th – this date will change with new positive cases. Additionally, we are suspending scheduled outdoor family visits. This has been updated on the COVID-19 Status Dashboard (attached).

Medical appointments are still permitted. When using Timbercrest’s transportation service, you will not be subject to a 14-day isolation period.

Regular COVID-19 testing will continue for the next 2 weeks for both employees and Manor residents. Health Care and Crestwood residents will be tested Tuesdays, November 3rd and 10th in their accommodations.

Residential residents will be tested Wednesdays, November 4th and 11th in the Assembly Room at the times listed below. When possible, follow the schedule below for shorter wait times and social distancing requirements.
