**RE: COVID-19 Updates**

A new case of COVID-19 was identified on Wednesday. Due to the circumstances surrounding this case, we are not required to lengthen the time of the current outbreak period at this time.

Indiana Department of Health and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services have developed guidance which allows us to keep portions of our community open to normal activities when there are cases of COVID-19 identified. As a result of this guidance and results of recent outbreak testing we are able to make a few changes.

The recent outbreak testing showed there are no new cases of COVID-19 associated with Health Care and Crestwood. The recent cases of COVID-19 have been limited to Residential Living area. This means two things:

- 1) Residential Living residents (Full Service and Option Plan) will continue with the current precautions in place until outbreak testing is complete. The next outbreak testing date is Tuesday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>. Once the tests results are known we will know when restrictions can be lifted. As a reminder, current restrictions in place are:
  - Indoor visits are suspended. Outdoor visits at designated visiting areas are encouraged and should be scheduled online through Timbercrest's COVID-19 Information page.
  - Social dining is suspended. The dining room is open but residents must safe distance.
  - Group activities are suspended. Residents are encouraged to find alternate individual activities.
  - Leaves from campus, except for medical appointments should not occur.
  
- 2) Health Care and Crestwood residents are able to return to receiving indoor visits, social dining, group activities, and leaves from campus. This is effective today. *Due to the restrictions in Residential, Residential residents are limited to outdoor visits with Health Care and Crestwood residents.*
