We are reporting a new COVID-19 case at Timbercrest from the weekend, a total of 3 new cases since the middle of last week.

HEALTH CARE and CRESTWOOD: The cases seem to be isolated to the healthcare area of our building so indoor visits and group activities will continue to be suspended in Health Care and Crestwood for a couple of weeks. Outdoor visits may continue and can be scheduled through Timbercrest's COVID-19 Information page. For visitation questions, please contact visits@timbercrest.org.

RESIDENTIAL LIVING: Residential Living residents (Full Service and Option Plan) may resume receiving indoor visits and group activities effective today. Outdoor visits are encouraged whenever possible and can be scheduled on our website.

We ask every member of our community to remain diligent in infection control practices – wear your face masks correctly in public and during visits, wash your hands frequently, and keep a safe distance (6 feet or more) from others whenever possible. Wabash County's positivity rate is over 16% (as of 9/3/21) which means there is more risk of infection. Your help and commitment is appreciated. Thank you.
