RE: COVID-19 Testing Update and Change in Dining Room Visits

Wabash County and surrounding areas have continued to see substantial increases in COVID-19 infections. Timbercrest, too, is seeing the same trend with increased COVID-19 infections over the last few weeks.

A few weeks ago, Timbercrest expanded testing of unvaccinated employees to include all employees regardless of their vaccination status. Last week, testing was expanded again to include all Manor residents as well. Over the course of two weeks, two new resident COVID infections were identified within the Crestwood wing. Residents living in Crestwood will continue to be tested weekly until no additional cases are identified. Weekly testing of residents in Health Care and Residential Living is not planned at this time.

Additionally, Timbercrest is suspending guest meals in resident dining rooms *effectively immediately* as an additional infection control measure. Residents and their visitors are encouraged to dine privately with each other off campus, in the resident's apartment, or in a designated visiting space. For the latter two options, please contact the reception areas in Residential or Health Care to make plans.
